

Event is regulated by the rules of Estonian Orienteeting Federation.

Eligibility to Participate

Participants are required to obtain an Estonian Orienteering Federation (EOL) license. One-time EOL license (valied for one start) can be purchased with the registration through the website Osport.ee.

Estonian Championship Special Rules

MIDDLE DISTANCE

Start list: Start list is drawn but first 10 orienteers of the EOL M21 leaderboard (dated 8 days before the Event) are placed in M21 start list to the last 10 positions in reverse order. First 6 orienteers of the EOL N21 leaderboard (dated 8 days before the Event) are placed in N21 start list to the last 6 positions in reverse order.

Start format: for classes MN21 – individual start with the start interval of 2 minutes. For all other classes – individual start with the interval of 3 minutes.

MN21 RELAY

Teams in M21 and N21 are with 3 legs. The distance of the 2nd leg is shorter, about 2/3 of the length of the other legs.

Price giving

MIDDLE DISTANCE

Winners (first three) in classes MN14, MN16, MN18, MN20 and MN21 who are Estonian citizens or have Estonian permanent residence permit are awarded with Estonian Championship medals.

Winners (first three) in classes MN35–80 who are Estonian citizens or have Estonian permanent residence permit or are members in some EOL member club are awarded with Estonian Championship medals.

MN21 RELAY

Winners (first three) in MN21 relay are awarded with Estonian Championship medals if the team members are from the same EOL member club.

Terrain and Map

There is two different types of terrain.

Northen part is more hilly with lots of demanding surface shapes. Total climb between the lowest and the highest point is around 32 m. Forest is dense and will slow you down. There are almost no roads. Two power lines cross the area, they are nicely cleaned and with good runnability.

Southern part is lower with marshes and moors between small mounds. Total climb between the lowest and the highest point is around 15 m. Forest is moderately dense, in some parts runnability is even good but here and there some windbreaks could be found. There are few roads, paths are overgrown and poorly visible.

The area belongs to Kõrvemaa Nature Reserve and there are no new areas of cutting of trees, only some light cutting could be found.


Punching System
